Sparkling & Champagne

1. **Prosecco 'Special Cuvee', Zonin, Italy, NV** **£20.00**
Delicate and elegant, this burgundian sparkling wine combines pear and floral aromas on the nose with a fresh, crispness on the palate.
2. **Gremillet Brut Selection, Champagne, NV** **£36.00**
A delicious, award winning Champagne, that is very smooth and elegant in style.

White Wines

3. **Jean Blanc, Cotes de Gascogne, S France** **£12.95**
An aromatic, fresh and delicate white, with gooseberry and elderflower fruit flavours.

4. **Jean Paul Demi Sec, S France** **£12.95**
A floral and aromatic southern French white with an attractive green apple bite that balances the residual sugar. Delicious as an aperitif.

5. **Domaine Bertier Sauvignon Viognier, S France** **£14.25**
Delicate lemony green in colour, this cool climate Sauvignon shows elegant grassy aromas with intense tropical, zesty fruit flavours.

6. **Ayama Chenin Blanc, South Africa** **£15.95**
A lively and refreshing Cape white, full of floral and green apple aromas. So soft and easy that it works with a variety of dishes.
7. **GPG Pinot Grigio Garganega, Italy** **£16.50**
Always incredibly popular, Pinot Grigio's simplicity is its attraction. Citrus & spice are married with nuttyness from the Garganega.
8. **Gavi, Riva Leone, Piemonte, Italy** **£17.25**
A very elegant white wine from Northern Italy, that works wonderfully with delicate meat and seafood dishes.
9. **Dart Valley Reserve, Sharpham Estate, Devon** **£19.95**
Elderflower and citrus fruit flavours with zesty acidity.
10. **Marmesa 'Edna Valley' Chardonnay, California** **£19.95**
A rich tropical Chardonnay from the warm Edna Valley in California. Incredible value for money.
11. **Fault Line Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** **£22.00**
A superb quaffer from Marlborough with gooseberry, citrus and mineral characters. Excellent clean, refreshing finish.
12. **Sancerre, Domaine Sautereau, Loire** **£26.00**
Spearminty Sancerre, classic gooseberry and smoky overtones.

Rosé Wines

13. **St Jean Rose, Vin de Pays d'Oc, S France** **£12.95**
A fresh and delicate rosé, packed with subtle summer fruit flavours.
By the Glass £3.40 (175ml) or £4.40 (250ml)
14. **Borsao Garnacha Rosé, Spain** **£15.25**
An intense, juicy rosé, full of red berry fruit with a touch of warmth.

Red Wines

15. **St Jean Rouge, Vin de Pays d'Oc, S France** **£12.95**
A classic southern French blend with dark berry fruit flavours.
By the Glass £3.40 (175ml) or £4.40 (250ml)
16. **The Paddock Shiraz, South Australia** **£15.25**
Black forest fruit flavours and spicy notes is what you should expect from a great Aussie Shiraz.
By the Glass £3.85 (175ml) or £5.20 (250ml)
17. **Piropo Merlot, Mendoza, Argentina** **£16.95**
Merlot thrives on the fertile plains of Mendoza; here resulting in a vibrant, fruit driven wine full of cassis flavours and tannin structure.
18. **Montepulciano, Villa dei Fiori, Italy** **£17.25**
Intense ruby red, light violet shades, full bodied and robust, with red fruit flavours and a velvety finish.
19. **Monte Clavijo Rioja, Spain** **£18.25**
An impressive, structured Rioja with enough juicy red berry fruit.
20. **Ayama Pinotage, Paarl, South Africa** **£19.95**
Full of character this Cape red offers both ripe strawberry fruit with a touch of spice and leather adding interest.
21. **Cotes du Rhone, Domaine de l'Ameillaud, S Rhone** **£20.75**
Produced by an extremely talented English winemaker. Dark fruit from the Syrah with plenty of warmth and spice.
22. **Fleurie 'La Madone', Reine de L'Arenite, Beaujolais** **£24.00**
A bright and juicy Fleurie, packed with raspberry fruit. Soft and easy in style.
23. **Parducci Pinot Noir, California** **£26.00**
Pinot is the grape of the moment, so popular it is. Packed with fruit and with a lovely silky texture. Ripe and very easy.

Dessert Wines

24. **Domaine du Noble, Loupiac, Bordeaux** **£15.00**
An outstanding dessert wine, produced from botrytis infected grapes in the small vineyard of Loupiac, close to Sauternes.
